

# Disclosure of Lead Water Service Line

## Lead Warning Statement

The City of Cincinnati prohibited the use of lead pipes for new private water service line connections in 1927. Water flowing from the treatment plant through the City-owned water mains is lead free. However, where the service line between the main and home is made of lead, lead may enter the water when passing through the service lines.

Lead from drinking water can pose health hazards if not managed properly. Lead exposure is especially harmful to young children and pregnant women. Before renting out units, landlords must disclose if the rental unit is known to be served by lead service lines. This *Disclosure of Lead Service Line Form* is required for compliance with Cincinnati Municipal Code 871-12.
